Eligibility

The 27th Annual All Colorado Art Show is open to all artists residing in Colorado, 18 years of age and older. Artwork must have been executed in the last two years and not previously shown at the Curtis Arts & Humanities Center. Employees of Greenwood Village and their relatives are not eligible.

Conditions of Exhibit

Entries must be original art in all forms of media (**jewelry, digital, giclee, prints or photography will not be accepted**). Only monoprints will be accepted and not prints. Each artist may submit a **maximum of two works per category**. All work must be properly framed and wired for hanging. Maximum size for two-dimensional work is 4'x5' (including frame) and for three-dimensional a maximum of 300 lbs. Exceptions allowed for work specifically intended to be unframed. Please conform to these standards. The receiving committee reserves the right of final decisions regarding specifications.

There is a two entry maximum for each category of two and/or three dimensional art. Bas-relief that can hang on the wall is considered to be a two-dimensional work. For all three-dimensional works, two images may be submitted. The juror has the right to reject art if the work does not reflect the image, or is not properly presented.

Digital Entries

Digital files should be submitted on a CD enclosed with your entry form (CD's will not be returned). Images must be formatted in jpeg, 1200 pixels in the longest dimension, and 300 dip.

Name your file by using your last name, first name and the title of the work. Example: Smith-John-Rockies.jpeg. Please make sure to use the jpeg extension.

On the CD write your name, address, phone, email address, and image title(s). Please enclose a printout of each digital images, this will be used for office reference only.

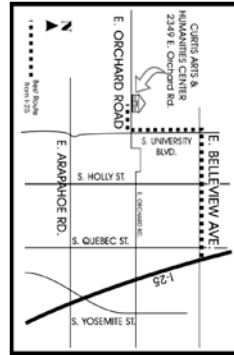

Work will be insured only while on the premises during the dates specified on this form. Claim reimbursement subject to verified value not to exceed 70% of the sale by appraisal and/or applicable criteria.

Insurance

Greenwood Village hereby agrees to extend its property insurance coverage to the artwork exhibited at the Center, and only until the date of removal stated on the signed form. Because the Village does not have available storage, if any loss, damage, or destruction occurs after that date, the Village will not be responsible, and the Village's insurance coverage will not apply.

Under the Village's property insurance policy, the artwork will be insured for a covered cause of loss, at the appraised value of the article, minus the Village's stated commission. Thus, for coverage purposes, it is important that you provide an accurate appraised value, and that you are able to provide one or more acceptable appraisals to document that value in case of loss.
