2010 Census Partner Proclamation

WHEREAS, an accurate census count is vital to our community and residents' well-being by helping planners determine where to locate schools, roads and public transportation, hospitals and other facilities, and achieving an accurate and complete count of the nation's growing and changing population;

WHEREAS, more than \$400 billion annually in federal and state funding is allocated to states and communities, based, in part, on census data;

WHEREAS, census data help determine how many seats each state will have in the U.S. House of Representatives and is often used for the redistricting of state legislatures, county and city councils and voting districts;

WHEREAS, the information collected by the census is confidential and protected by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nancy Sharpe, Mayor of the City of Greenwood Village, do hereby proclaim that Greenwood Village is committed to partnering with the U.S. Census Bureau to help ensure a full and accurate count in 2010.

As a 2010 Census partner, Greenwood Village will:

1. Support the goals for the 2010 Census and disseminate the 2010 Census information to encourage those in our community to participate.
2. Encourage people in our community to place an emphasis on the 2010 Census and raise overall awareness to help ensure a full and accurate census.
3. Support the Census Bureau, whenever possible, to undertake this effort.
