4th Of July Firework Reminder!

Fireworks are a traditional part of America's July 4th Independence Day celebration. For many of us, the 4th of July just is not complete without sparklers and the oohs and aahs as it gets dark and the big show begins. However, the Greenwood Village Police Department would like to remind citizens that the possession and use of fireworks of any kind are illegal in Greenwood Village according to Chapter 8.08 of the Municipal Code.

Colorado is already experiencing a hot and dry summer. Fireworks can increase the danger of brush fires in our open spaces and present a fire danger to residential properties. To avoid a possible fireworks-related injury, or starting a fire, it is best to leave the fireworks shows to the professionals. On Saturday, July 26, 2008, immediately following the annual Greenwood Village Day event, the Village will offer a spectacular fireworks display for residents.
