I-25 Road Rage

On January 2, 2017, at 2:00 a.m., Greenwood Village police officers saw what appeared to be two vehicles (a white Acura and a red Geo Metro) racing on Southbound I-25. Officers initiated a traffic stop, where the white Acura pulled over. The driver of the Acura told officers that he was driving next to the Geo Metro and saw an arm come out of the driver's side window holding a gun and then heard a pop noise and believed that his rear passenger window had been shot by the occupant of the red Geo Metro. The driver of the Acura was not injured. The driver of the Acura was able to provide officers with a license plate to the Geo Metro. Greenwood Village detectives are currently investigating this crime.
