STUDY SESSION

Study Sessions are set aside for Council to have discussions and gather information and study issues more in depth before taking any actions at a Regular Meeting. Residents are invited to hear the discussions in-person or listen online via the [Village's live online audio-stream](#), but are not allowed to participate in Study Session. Recent discussions include:

Fiddler's Business Improvement District Discussion

The Fiddler's Business Improvement District is a special district that is required to file an operating plan and budget with the Village each year. The management of the Fiddler's Business Improvement District has recently changed due to a recent conveyance of property from John Madden Company to Schnitzer West, LLC. Their representatives were in attendance to discuss the recent transition and their future initiatives.

Implementation of House Bill 21-1162 and Senate Bill 21-260 Regarding Single Use Carry-Out Bags and Delivery Fees

The Council held a discussion with the City Attorney regarding [setting a policy on whether or not to tax carry-out bag and delivery fees](#) that have been imposed by the State of Colorado.

- Study Session Continued -

The current Greenwood Village Municipal Code states that such state-imposed fees would be taxable as they are part of the total purchase price of an item. Council directed the City Attorney to bring forward an ordinance to change the Municipal Code to exempt the carry-out bag fee and delivery fee from taxation by the City.

The proposed ordinance will come before City Council on first reading October 3, 2022.

COUNCIL MEETING

Council takes action at Regular Meetings which are open to the public for in-person attendance and also [audio-streamed live via the Village's website](#). Recent actions include:

Consent Agenda (Approved without separate discussion)
Council adopted these routine items without a separate vote.

- **[Resolution No. 33-22](#)**, which rescinded Resolution No. 42, Series 2007 regarding the comparable compensation Labor Market. This allows the City to utilize third-party survey market data per the new compensation philosophy recently approved by City Council.
- **[Resolution No. 35-22](#)**: A Resolution Re-appointing Deborah Tolley to the Greenwood Village Arts and Humanities Council and Establishing an Expiration Date of Her Term

New Business

- Council approved a motion to authorize the Mayor to sign an **[Intergovernmental Agreement with the Mile High Flood District](#)** for drainage and flood control improvements for Goldsmith Gulch downstream of Berry Avenue. This agreement formalizes the funding needed to begin the design process to stabilize the channel to address erosion concerns.
- Council approved a motion to authorize the Mayor to sign an **[Intergovernmental Agreement with Arapahoe County](#)** for the Village Greens North Park Phase V. This agreement is required so the City can partner with the county to use Arapahoe County Open Space funds that will be matched by the City.
