How to Play

Disc golf is played like ball golf, except that a flying disc is used.

The object of the game is to land your disc into the metal basket using the fewest number of throws possible. Each time a disc is thrown, it counts as a stroke. The winner is the player with the lowest score (fewest strokes) after playing all of the holes.

Tee throws (the first throw on each hole) must be made from the designated tee area. After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the basket always throws first.

All throws (except tee throws) must be made from where the disc landed. A run-up and follow-through is allowed for most throws, as long as you release the disc behind the spot where the previous throw landed.

When you are close to the basket (within 33 feet), you are not allowed to run-up and follow-through.

Never throw until the players in front of you are out of reach, and the fairway is completely clear of other park users.

Disc Golf Course Rules

- The Greenwood Village Disc Golf Course is for foot traffic only with the exception of ADA mobility devices. Bicycle, equestrian, or motorized traffic is not permitted.
- Be respectful of neighboring residents, wildlife, vegetation, and fellow park visitors.
- Obey all signs along the course.
- Respect course closures.
- Do not litter – carry out all trash.
- Please respect the course as it is designed. Using trees or other features as targets can damage those features.
- No groups larger than 6 players may play on the same hole.
- Slower groups should let faster groups play through.
- Players must yell “FORE” on errant throws heading toward other players and park users.
- Use caution near other park activity areas such as trails.
- Where possible, utilize the trail leading from the tee to the basket. This will help preserve the native vegetation in the area.
